

## Criteria for identifying Able, Gifted and Talented Students at Hethersett Academy

### Department: **History**

#### Whole Academy Criteria:

- Enthusiasm and curiosity for the subject and for learning
- Ability to quickly grasp new concepts, content and vocabulary
- Keen to develop their work and extend their ideas
- Willingness to work independently and outside of lesson time
- Ability to put/use a new idea in context
- Clear communication, justification and reasoning

#### Department Specific Criteria:

- Students show a desire to gain a greater depth of knowledge about the topic being studied
- Ability to quickly grasp new concepts and to link these to previous learning
- An ability to set new learning within a wider historical context and to see similarities and differences across historical periods.
- A desire to engage in their own research which widens their historical knowledge
- The ability to use key historical vocabulary and concepts in producing extended pieces of writing
- The ability to use carefully selected evidence to produce a sustained analysis of historical question
